Qualified health care professionals may report 99483 as frequently as once per 180 days, per CPT. However, payer policy may say otherwise and should be consulted. Care plans should be revised at intervals and whenever there is a change in the patient’s clinical or caregiving status. Medicare intermediaries may audit the frequency of use.

IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE UNIVERSAL HEALTH ...

Universal health care in most countries has been achieved by a mixed model of funding. General taxation revenue is the primary source of funding, but in many countries it is supplemented by specific charge (which may be charged to the individual or an employer) or with the option of private payments (by direct or optional insurance) for services beyond those covered by the public system.

1 Note that 29 CFR 1910.1020 may apply to temperature records. Health care in the United States is provided by many distinct organizations, made up of insurance companies, healthcare providers, hospital systems, and independent providers. Health care facilities are largely owned and operated by private sector businesses. 58% of community hospitals in the United States are non-profit, 21% are government-owned, and 21% are for-profit.
