Although best known for its service with the Royal Air Force, the Mosquito flew in several US Army Air Force units as a photographic and weather reconnaissance aircraft, and as a night fighter. During the war, the USAAF acquired 40 Canadian Mossies and flew them under the American F-8 (photo reconnaissance) designation.

The de Havilland Mosquito first entered service with the RAF in 1941. The twin Rolls Royce Merlins and clean aerodynamics gave it a top speed of over 400MPH. It was constructed of almost entirely wood, including balsa! The wood was molded into the curved shapes and bonded together.
