Safe rooms are built to specific standards to provide ultimate safety. Currently, the highest-grade safe room design is the FEMA P-320 and P-361. These safe rooms can be located inside or outside a residence or public place and protect against extreme winds up to 250 mph and flying debris that are associated with severe storms.

"These alternative safe rooms work best because of their absence of windows," says Buzz Weiss, Georgia Emergency Management Agency (GEMA). There are three options for the location of a safe room: attached, basement, or detached. It is easiest to construct a communal safe room during new construction of a public building. However, if the building has a sound basement and is in an area with a low flooding risk, it is possible to remodel and build a below-ground safety shelter.

Risk management strategies Staff should escort patients presenting with a behavioral health complaint directly into the ED or other safe location where they can be observed. High risk patients should not be left in the waiting room as this can increase anxiety which can lead to agitation and/or elopement.
